Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.Excerpt from Air Ambulance Service: Report to the 1985 General Assembly of North Carolina Pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 120-30.17(1), the Legislative Research Commission authorized an air ambulance committee to study the feasibility of and make recommendations for an air ambulance system in North Carolina. The committee was chaired by Senator Aaron Plyler and Representative Joe Hackney. Interest in a statewide air ambulance system first arose in the early 1970 s. In 1973, the General Assembly enacted the Emergency Medical Services Act, which authorized the Secretary of the Department of Human Resources to promote the development of an air ambulance support system to supplement ground vehicle operations (N.C.G.S. 143-509(8)). In the following years, the Department s Office of Emergency Medical Services produced a draft paper on air ambulances and financed both a study of a fixed-wing air ambulance system and a demonstration air ambulance project using a helicopter. None of these efforts materialized into a statewide air ambulance system. However, interest in the proposal was renewed in 1983, particularly among the larger hospitals. In February, 1984,...
