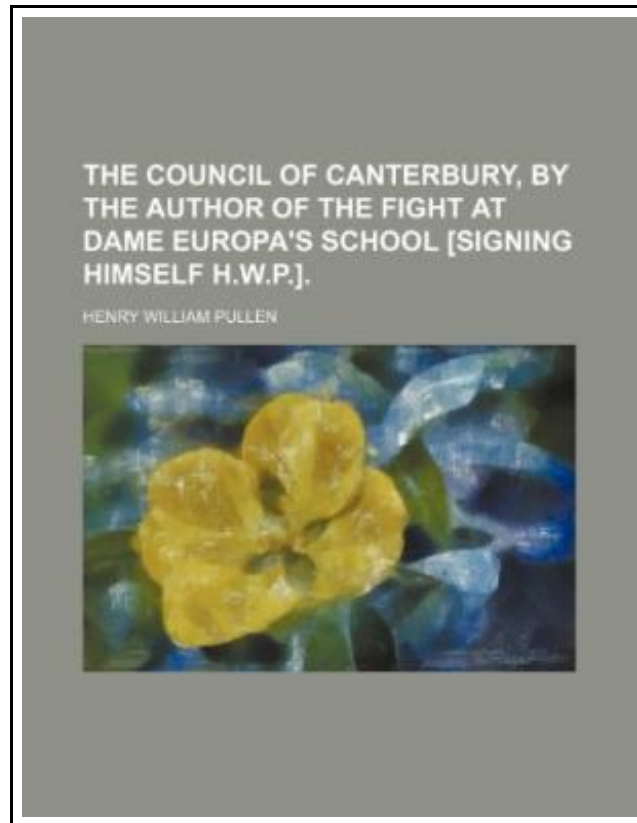

There must always be difficulties, observed the Canon, consolingly....
