In tabulating all thunderstorms which passed over Baltimore during a period of 28 years, a total of 678, we find the following distribution by months: Fig. 77. -- The Frequency and Distribution of Thunderstorms. The diagram represents over 650 thunderstorms which passed over Baltimore in the 30 years from 1871 to 1900. The density of the shading increases with the frequency of the storms, showing a maximum frequency between 3 p. m. and 5 p. m. in the month of July. For the hours of the day and month during which less than five storms were recorded...
