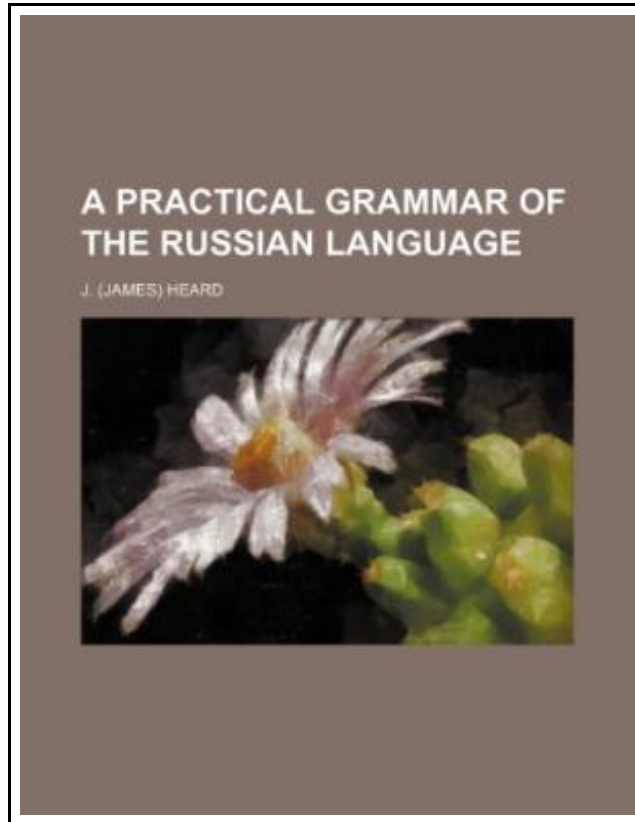

The auxiliary verb *был* added to the past of the definite branch corresponds to the English pluperfect; as, *был сделан* - I had made a mistake, *было сделано* - it was made, but corrected it in time. The same verb with the past tense of the verb *идти* and the infinitive of the principal verb corresponds to the English *was going*; as, *был идти* - I was going to ride, *было идти* - it was going to ride, but was prevented by the bad weather. The auxiliary verb *использовал* added to the past tense of a verb, corresponds to the English *used to* followed by the infinitive; as, *использовал бежать* - I used to run about the meadows. *использовал ходить* - I used to walk thirty miles a day. Prefixed to the present tense it expresses the same idea in a more lively manner. *использовал говорить* - I used to speak, while he was playing. The infinitive is used in the Russian language without any preposition or sign; as, *хочу знать* - I wish to know, *учиться говорить* - Learn to speak correctly. When the infinitive is preceded by the conjunction *чтобы* or *что* it expresses the end of the action; as, *нужно читать* - It is necessary to read much and write much to know and understand a...
